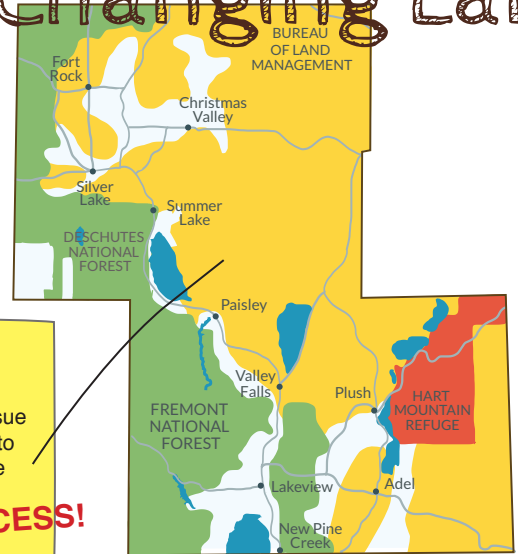

# STARTUP BRAINSTORMING & LAUNCH OF ENGAGEMENT ACTIVITIES

## INITIAL PLANNING:

- + PLAYA, LCRI & U.S. Forest Service Group determines community capacity & interest; + Artists, climate scientists, climate change policy experts, geologist Group brainstorm clear intent, goals, approach and first steps
- + Grant writing - unsuccessful & successful
- + Build many relationships in community
- + Increased partnerships in community

## FIRST PHASE ENGAGEMENT ACTIVITIES

- + Community conversations prompted by manipulated landscape photos
- + 3 landscape photography workshops
- + Community landscape photo show in 3 library locations
- + "Our Lake County" interactive Re-mapping website designed and launched
- + Artist-led "Relationship to Land & Environment" stories gathered through 25 one-on-one interviews and 3 community conversations
